LEOSA Handgun Qualification



Course

Description: Officers will be asked to engage targets at various distances and demonstrate working knowledge and proper manipulation of their weapon, including proficiency from their chosen mode of carry. Officers will perform reloads and clear malfunctions as needed, without assistance. Officers may load administratively, as some may not carry enough ammunition for the entire course of fire.

Firearms Instructors should review SPD policy regarding off-duty carry and discuss current Use-of-Force case law with all retirees. The Rangemaster should also cover post-shooting identification and safety considerations for interactions with responding law enforcement officers.

Scoring consists of hits within the torso, neck, and head of the silhouette target. Shots to extremities (arms, grazes, etc.) will not count. While a shooter may achieve a qualifying score, the Firearms Instructor reserves the right to require remediation of the entire course or have the shooter demonstrate proficiency and/or reshoot any stage to the instructor's satisfaction.

Course of Fire:

<u>Range</u>	<u># of Rounds</u>	<u>Start Position</u>	<u>Repetitions</u>
3 Yrds	2	Mode of Carry	2
5 Yrds	2	Mode of Carry	2
5 Yrds	3 (2 torso + 1 head)	Low ready	1
7 Yrds	2 reload 2	Low Ready	2

Total (19) Rounds 70% = 13 hits
